

SAY NO to Heathrow Expansion -2- Attend the rally on Monday 25 February

The Government is consulting on the biggest-ever programme of expansion at Heathrow Airport. Very few Chiswick residents have been asked their views. The consultation offers limited ways to request information or register opposition.

So how can you make your voice heard? Local residents have identified four priorities:

- 1) Respond to the formal consultation – before Wednesday 27 February;*
- 2) Attend the consultation rally – at Westminster on Monday 25 February;*
- 3) Write to other Ministers and MPs;*
- 4) Follow up other sources of information and action.*
